HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the head of Josh Creek, about 2½ miles west-southwest of Paulson; in the early 1900's the area was known as "Burnt Basin".

Tammany Gold Mines, Limited, incorporated December 1899, held the Tammany group of 8 claims. The Tammany No. 1, Burnt Basin, and Jim Blaine (Lots 1135-1137, respectively) were Crown-granted to the company in 1901; the Jim Blaine Fr. (Lot 1140), Burnt Basin Fr. (Lot 1141), and Last Chance Fr. (Lot 2597) were Crown-granted in 1902. The workings in 1901 included a 130 foot adit on the Tammany No. 1 claim. The company charter was surrendered in 1912.

Dalex Mines Ltd. held 35 claims in 1968-69. Work included induced potential and geochemical soil surveys.

Burnt Basin Mines Ltd. was incorporated in 1971 to acquire 21 Crown-granted claims and fractions and 15 mineral leases. Donna Mines Ltd. in 1972 optioned an 80% interest in the property.
