A quartz vein carries free gold near surface.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The claims are located at the east side of Burnt Basin, from 1½ to 2 miles south of Paulson.

Five years assessment work, including a 20 foot shaft, was reported on the property in 1901. The Kittie, Aldeen, and Tunnel claims (Lots 1748-1750, respectively) were Crown-granted to W.B. Townsend in 1901.

Burnt Basin Mines Ltd. was incorporated in 1971 to acquire 21 Crown-granted claims and fractions and 15 mineral leases, including the above three claims. Donna Mines Ltd. in August 1972 optioned an 80% interest in the property.
