HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

In 1972, 47 tons of ore was shipped from the Eva Bell claim. From this ore 309 ounces of silver, 7,439 pounds of lead, and 15,737 pounds of zinc were recovered. (Donna Mines Ltd. - Statement of Material Facts).

During 1973-74 a total of 466 tons of ore were shipped, possibly from either the Eva Bell or Halifax. From this ore 34 ounces of gold, 1,253 ounces of silver, 25,616 pounds of lead, 44,165 pounds of zinc, and 329 pounds of cadmium were recovered. REFERENCES
