One shaft down 45ft and a second about 15ft. Vein averages about 18 in. Claim has recently been surveyed and a Crown grant applied for.

(B.C.Rep.1896 - p.575).

Small quartz vein traced 50ft in surface, sunk shaft 55ft deep on vein. In shaft vein was  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft wide Log cabins, bunk house, etc., have been erected. 13 men at work. Maj. A. McGraw, Supt. (B.C.Rep.1897, p.606).

Development in 1898. (B.C.Rep.1898 - p.1117)

" " 1899. Mine equipped with 5-drill compressor, 4 air-drills and double cylinder steam hoist. (B.C.Rep.1899 p.773).

"Minnie-ha-ha Gp." consolidated with "Sailor Gp." in 1900. (B.C.Rep.1900 - p.880).

Well equipped 10-stamp mill (1050 lbs.) one 6ft Frue Vanner and one Wilfly table, Blake crusher and a 35-h.boiler and engine. The mill was run for three weeks in March 1900 and has been idle since. No operations in 1901. (B.C.Rep.1901 p.1151).

Property has been idle since 1901. (M.&E.Rec.July 1921).
