Rich strike, assays as high as \$80 per ton.  
(B.C.Rep. 1899 - p.774).  
Shaft sunk 45ft with 10ft <sup>filled</sup> crosscut to find  
ore because dyke was evidently faulted.  
Open-cut 80ft x 8 to 10ft deep showing bands  
of iron oxide running high in free gold.  
Sample of bottom of cut gave Gold \$14.20, and  
Silver 0.5 oz.per ton. The develop't so far  
has shown that the property has some promise  
(B.C.Rep.1901 - p.1153).  
The owners after bonding it and receiving it  
back again have undertaken to operate the  
property and are getting out a small ship-  
ment of ore. (B.C.Rep.1903 - p.168).
