DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A fine-grained basic igneous dyke is exposed on this claim. It is impregnated with fine particles of magnetic iron, a little copper and some gold values.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Jim Crow claim is situated on Lot 1951, on a ridge between the main Rock Creek and the south fork of the same creek.

In 1901, it was owned by C.E. Hamilton who sunk a shaft down 10 feet, partly timbered.

A sample from the dyke assayed 2.3% copper; 1 oz./ton silver and traces of gold.

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold, silver.
