DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are greenstone volcanics of Triassic or older age. Attitude of the flows are variable in the vicinity of the showings but, in general, are steeply dipping and strike north to northeast. Chalcopyrite occurs as scattered finely disseminated grains and tiny blebs in a moderately silicified massive andesite flow about 300 feet thick. There is a vague banding in the andesite which appears to dip about 50° to the west and strikes just east of north. The sulphide mineralization includes pyrite and possibly very small amounts of bornite. Mineralization has been noted over a strike length of about 1,200 feet. A selected sample from a small pit blasted in bedrock on the west side of the showings assayed: copper, 0.66%; molybdenite, 0.01%; gold, trace; silver, trace. A 5-foot chip sample across dip in the pit assayed: copper, 0.15%; molybdenite, 0.01%; gold, trace; silver, trace.

This property is located on Manuel Creek about 4 miles east of Keremeos.

The original exploration work on the property was, as far as is known, done during the 1930's and includes open cuts and a 50 foot inclined shaft.

Libra Mines Ltd., incorporated in January 1967, staked the Libra claim Nos. 1-34 and the Lost Copper claim Nos. 1 and 2. Prado Explorations Limited optioned the claims in June 1967 and staked an adjoining group, Libra claim Nos. 35-62. Libra Mines Ltd. personnel blasted a small pit in bedrock on the showings. Work by Prado in 1967 included geological mapping and a geochemical soil survey (about 900 samples).
