DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A vein averaging about 8 inches in width strikes east-west and dips about 60 degrees north.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc, lead.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 4,300 foot elevation at the head of Dominion Creek, about  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles south-southeast of Beaverdell.

The Scandia claim, owned in 1916 by W.M. Smith, was optioned to Eric Jackson, of Phoenix, B.C. Exploration work during the period 1916 to 1918 was done in a 90-foot adit and a 12-foot winze.

Silver Scandie Mines Limited was incorporated in 1960 to acquire the Scandie group of 17 claims. The old adit was extended to a length of 190 feet and a new adit, just above the creek bed, was driven for 155 feet. A small amount of ore was shipped during this period of activity. The company was dissolved in 1972.

## HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

In 1960, 6 tons of ore were shipped from this property. From this ore 350 ounces of silver, 451 pounds of lead, and 840 pounds of zinc were recovered.
