HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 4,000 foot elevation on Cranberry Ridge, northwest of the Inyo-Ackworth property.

The Nipper group, comprising the Nipper, Jubilee, Silver Cable, and Radio claims, was held from about 1916 by Messrs. Dale, Morton, and Sheridan. By 1925 the workings included open cuts, shallow shafts, and 3 crosscut adits, 20, 60, and 160 feet in length. In 1928 the claims were optioned to Washington interests, but no work was reported.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Shear zones about 2 feet in width, and with a general north-easterly strike, occur in schist near a quartz diorite contact. The shears carry quartz veins mineralized with pyrite, galena, and sphalerite. A sample from an oxidized vein on the Nipper claim assayed: gold, 0.20 ounce per ton; silver, 26 ounces per ton; lead, 32%. In the lower crosscut a 2 inch quartz vein assayed: gold, 0.50 ounce per ton; silver, 3 ounces per ton; lead, 0.5%; zinc, 5%.

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver, lead, zinc.
