DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are argillites, limestones and quartzites of the Slocan series cut by dykes and sills. In the vicinity of the claim the rocks are banded argillites striking N15°W and dipping 75°NE. The vein, containing in places high-grade silver-lead ore, several inches wide, strikes nearly east and dips 50° south. It is believed to be part of the Minniehaha lode.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This claim is located about a mile southwest of Sandon on the east branch of Tributary creek at the 4,800 foot elevation. It lies along the west side of the Ruth-Hope property. Very little of the history of the development of this property has been recorded. It was Crown-granted to the Ruth No. Two Mining Co. Ltd. in 1899. The owner of the claim in 1926 was J.P. Wilson of Sandon and apparently some of the development work was done by him at about this time. In 1935 the claim was reported owned by C.B. White of New Denver. About 1952 the claim was owned by Kelowna Exploration Co. Ltd. The upper workings were reported to be caved at this time. The property is developed by two adits, the one 125 feet lower than the other. The lower adit was driven 220 feet at south 60°E to a raise driven upwards at 30 degrees. A 100 foot branch to the northeast ends in another short raise.
