## HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

Production records are incomplete. The first shipments were made in 1899. These totalled 19 tons having an average of 106 ounces of silver to the ton and containing 53 per cent lead. In 1900 over 100 tons were reported sacked at the mine. Shipments to Trail from 1904 to 1909 amounted to 64 tons. No production has been recorded since that time.
