This claim was Crown-granted at the Gem in 1898. All production has been derived by placer methods, from float. Although attempts have been made to find the source of the float, these have not been successful. In recent years the claim has apparently been renamed Shady Fraction.

**HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION**

Between 1917 and 1923 some 60 tons of ore were shipped from the Gem claim, from which 4,764 ounces of silver and 84,828 pounds of lead were recovered.

In 1950, and again in 1955, small shipments of float, totalling 3 tons, were made. This ore had a gross content of 235 ounces of silver, 4,023 pounds of lead, and 180 pounds of zinc.
