DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The greater part of the claim is underlain by part of a granodiorite porphyry stock invading Slocan sediments. Along the northeast claim boundary, sedimentary strata occupy a width of about 100 feet, and extend northerly beyond the claim for about ¼ mile. A wider band of sediments underlies the southwestern part of the claim. The sediments consist of interbedded limestone, slate and andalusite schists, which are cut by porphyry dykes. In the sedimentary strip along the northeast claim line, 3 adits have been driven on a lode which has a maximum width of 2½ to 3 feet. The zone is largely composed of crushed and broken rock sparingly impregnated with sulphides and containing a discontinuous streak 2 to 3 inches wide, of vein matter, mostly galena, but containing also some sphalerite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This claim was Crown-granted in 1911. Three adits were driven in a southerly direction near the northeasterly claim line, in a direction parallel with, and within a few yards of the northern edge of the body of granodiorite. The uppermost and lowermost are about 250 feet apart vertically and over 300 feet horizontally. The lowermost adit is about 300 feet long, but the length of the other two is not known. A fourth adit is located about 375 feet west of, and nearly 400 feet below the lowest of the 3 adits referred to. This adit is not accessible, but has been driven under an outcrop oxidized vein matter about 10 feet wide. The relationship of this lode to the easterly lode is not known, but they are probably different lodes.

The last record of activity on this property was in 1937, when 9 tons of ore, yielding 393 ounces of silver and 5,042 pounds of lead, was mined.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

The only production recorded from this property, was the shipment of 9 tons made in 1937.
