HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The claim lies between the two forks of Howson creek, a tributary of Carpenter creek, at an elevation of about 5,800 feet. The nearest road to the claim is the Alamo mine road.

The claim was staked about 1898 and some development work was done at that time and again in 1903. Open cuts trace the vein over the ridge to the east of the lower Alamo basin. An adit was driven from the western slope a short distance below the outcrop. It is 150 feet long and crosses the vein 40 feet from the portal. A drift follows the vein for 72 feet to the northeast.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are banded quartzites and silty argillites, black slates, and more calcareous strata of the Slocan series. These have a general anticlinal structure dipping both to the northeast and southwest at various angles. The structure is complicated by faulting and cross-folding with consequent great variations in attitude. Penetrating these sediments are porphyritic intrusives chiefly in the form of dykes. The claim is believed to be on the same vein as the Alamo mine, a short distance to the northwest. On the Conductor claim the vein is oxidized to a width of about 6 inches and contains small amounts of galena. The exact nature of the mineralization is not known but the ore would presumably also contain some silver and zinc.
