DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are argillites and limestones of the Slocan series, Folding and faulting has produced wide variations in attitude of the beds. Mineralization occurs as replacement deposits in the limestone, mainly at the centres of the local shattering. Details of the mineralization are not known but the ore would probably also contain some silver and zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The claim is located on Silver Ridge, near the headwaters of the east fork of Howson creek. It was Crown-granted to N. Hickey in 1902.

A small account of digging was done years ago on the ridge crest on a breccia zone in argillite. Stripping of a limestone bed which outcrops on the steep north slope of the ridge uncovered some sulphide mineralization.
