DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

This deposit consists of a quartz fissure vein from a few inches to over a foot in width containing argentiferous galena. The vein cuts siliceous argillites and quartzites, strikes N75°E and dips 75° southeast.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property, located on the northwest slope of Idaho Mountain, was owned in 1935 by California Clipper S.L. Mines, Limited. The claims were worked intermittently from 1896 to 1907. Since that time there has been no record of any development. The workings include 2 crosscut adits, from which drifts have been driven.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

In the period 1896 to 1907 shipments totalling 343 tons were recorded from this property. This ore averaged 88 ounces of silver to the ton and contained 52% lead.
