DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are argillites, quartzites, limestones and schists of the Slocan series, dipping to the west at about 45°. Small quartz stringers $\frac{1}{2}$ to 6 inches wide occur in a steep dipping fracture zone in a calcareous black argillite. These stringers carry small amounts of galena, sphalerite, tetrahedrite and argentite. Assays as high as 600 ounces a ton in silver have been obtained.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the north side of Woodbury Creek about 4 miles by road from the main highway. Development work has apparently been confined to two periods, the first from 1938-40, the last in 1946. This was carried out by a number of different owners and leasers. Four adits have been driven on the fracture zone. The two upper adits are about 50 feet vertically apart and mineralized stringers occur in both. In the two lower adits the fracture zone is barren.

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HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

From 1938 to 1946, 32 tons of ore were shipped from this property. From this ore 4,597 ounces of silver, 7,111 pounds of lead and 1,958 pounds of zinc were recovered.
