DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The underlying rocks are argillites, limestone and quartzites of the Proterozoic Aldridge and Dutch Creek Formations. Galena, sphalerite and cassiterite occur in quartz veins in metasedimentary rock. Chalcopyrite and pyrrhotite are disseminated in a diorite sill.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the north side of Summit Creek, between Topaz and Toby Creeks, some 20 km west of Creston.

The Topaz and Toby groups, comprising 15 claims, were owned in 1969 by Magog Mining Co. Ltd. Work included magnetic and electromagnetic surveys over Topaz 1-5 and trenching.

Greenwich Resources Inc held the property in 1984; a geochemical silt survey was reported.
