DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The upper part of the mountain is underlain by Precambrian dolomites and argillites of the Kitchener and Siyeh Formations. Hematite occurs in short veins cutting a dark, fine-grained igneous body, presumed to be a dyke. It also occurs in seams along what appears to be planes of fractures cutting siliceous strata and quartz veins, and as disseminations in the sedimentary strata.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT 82G/11 FE 1
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at the 7,000' elevation on what was locally known as Fenwick Mountain, on the east side of the Bull River, 11 miles west of Fernie.

The occurrence was discovered prior to 1900 and staked in 1901. Some surface work was done in open cuts. Seven claims, including the Goliath (Lot 6346), Hematite (Lot 6348), and others (Lots 6347, 6349-6352) were Crown-granted to J.T. Laidlaw in 1907.

Great West Mining Corporation Ltd. was incorporated in 1961 to develop the Bull River iron deposits, however, no work was reported.
