A quarry was opened up on the Sunrise claim and operated during 1926 and 1927. Shipments were made to the Canada Cement Co's. plant at Exshew, Alta.

1946: The Western Cypsum Products. Ltd., erected a new plaster and wall board plant in Calgary.
Output is shipped there.
Operations were commenced in Aug. 1945.

A half dozes is used to scrape of overhanders and a face cut down to expose full thickness of gypreum. Broken gypreum is lucked to railway for shipment. The gypreum is not unform in comfortion and enteres their backs are found at depth or a cheap method of hemeficialisms democrated it may not be possible to continue.
