A phosphate bed about 1 metre thick occurs at the base of the Jurassic Fernie Formation.

The property is located on the south side of Lodgepole Creek, 3.5 km east of Windfall Mountain and some 33 km south-southeast of Fernie.

Imperial Oil Limited held the Lodge 1 claim (20 units) at this location in 1977; work included a geochemical survey (20 samples) and 250 metres of drilling in 10 downhole hammer holes.

Crows Nest Industries Limited located and examined claims southeast of Lodgepole creek in 1967.
