DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The deposit is very similar to that found on the Lead Queen group adjoining to the south and may be on the extension of the Lead Queen vein. Samples of ore from the Steele group have a gneissic structure and show replacement of crushed carbonate gangue and pyrite by galena, sphalerite, and tetrahedrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Steele group is located at the 8,300 foot elevation north of and adjoining the Lead Queen property. Work on the Steele group began in about 1900 and in 1917 the Steele (Lot 12499) and Steen No. 2 (Lot 12500) claims were Crown-granted to Messrs. Williamson, Cobb, Cottle, and Scott.

The Alice Arm Holdings Company, of Vancouver, acquired the property in about 1922 and part time work was continued into 1925. The vein has been developed by two crosscut adits and an unknown amount of drifting.
