The "American" was acquired in 1901 by the "Mountain Lion Mining & Development Co.Ltd., "which has driven a cross-cut tunnel 55 ft. intersecting the vein at a depth of 35 ft. from the surface; a drift was then continued on the vein for a distance of 185 ft. The above work has proven a vein 1 to 3 ft. wide carrying galena & carbonates. The value of this ore is about \$100 per ton but no shipments have been made, (Report of Minister of Mines for B.C. 1901)

A crosscut tunnel of 605 ft is now being driven to top

of the vein at depth of 800 ft.
