A narrow vein of silver-bearing galena can be traced a considerable distance. The host rock is Cambrian to Devonian or older phyllites of the Lardeau Group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The claims are located at about 7,500' elevation on the summit between the north forks of Hall and Healy creeks, some 14 miles east of the north end of Trout Lake and 48 miles southeast of Revelstoke.

The claims were staked prior to 1897 and Crown-granted (Lots 3478 and 3479) in 1900 to W.T. Oliver and associates. The claims adjoin the west side of the southeasterly extension of the Wagner property (82 K/11, PB 6) and were no doubt examined on a number of occasions in subsequent years.

The property was acquired by Bannockburn Resources Ltd in about 1983. In 1985 the claims were optioned by the Turner Energy & Resources Ltd and Mikado Resources Ltd joint venture, which held the adjacent Wagner property.
