The property is located between elevations of 5,000 and 7,500' on the north side of Hall Creek, some 16 miles east of the north end of Trout Lake and 48 miles southeast of Revelstoke.

Assessment work was reported in 1897. The Little Tommy, Death-on-the-Trail, Midnight and Morning claims (Lots 4985-4988 respectively) were Crown-granted to G.H. Bayne in 1901-02.

In 1977 the property was owned by J.A.C. Ross and associates and under option to S.E.R.E.M. Ltd. The claims were overstaked in part by the Ban 2, 3 and 5 claims. Work was apparently confined to the nearby Bannockburn property (82 K/11, PB 5). Ross and associates incorporated Bannockburn Resources Ltd in 1981. The several properties held by the company were optioned to the Turner Energy & Resources Ltd and Mikado Resources Ltd joint venture in 1985.
