Argentiferous galena reportedly occurs in a quartz vein.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the head of Boyd and Silvertip Creeks, approximately 12 miles northeast of Trout Lake. The Glengarry group was reported to be on Silvertip Creek and on the divide between this and Boyd Creek. The Kootenay Chief group was reported to be at the extreme head of Boyd Creek.

The Glengarry claim was located in 1892. Development work, done mainly in 1898, included a 25 foot crosscut adit and 22 feet of drift on the vein. The Glengarry (Lot 1971) and Prince Edward (Lot 1973) were Crown-granted in 1899 to L. Arthur and associates.

The Kootenay Chief group was first reported on in 1898. Work to 1899 included a 50 foot adit on the Kootenay Chief and a 30 foot adit on the Winnipeg claim. Three claims, the Kootenay Chief (Lot 2147), Winnipeg (Lot 2150), and Tamarcan (Lot 2151) were Crown-granted in 1901 to A. Blackwood and associates, of Winnipeg.
