DEVELOPMENT WORK

Since 1903 the deposit has been prospected intermittently by different lessees. In 1919 the Bullock Gold Mines did considerable exploratory and development work, built a trail and 2 cabins. There was an old shaft on the vein and in 1920 some underground work in and around the old shaft was done.

In 1921, development work was continued in a small way and in 1922 a small Ross Mill installed. Property closed down June 30, 1923.
