DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1059 A shows a northerly striking fault zone in this vicinity separating the Silver Creek and Chase Formations of the Archean or Later Shuswap Terrane. Fluorite occurs in quartz veins up to 20 cm thick and as thin (2 mm) fracture fillings in andesite and syenite.
