#### DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by massive granite of the Nelson pluton close to its northern edge. Mineralization is associated with a swarm of alkili dykes and a strong, persistent zone of shearing and brecciation which has been traced for over 550 feet and varies in width from 1 foot to over 40 feet. Pyrite, arsenopyrite, and sulphosalts, carrying gold and silver values, occur in fault gouge, quartz, carbonate, and intensely altered granite in the shear zone. The property is located astride Highway 6 about 1,500' southwest of McIntyre Lake in the Monashee Pass area some 55 km southeast of Vernon.

The Top 1 and 2 and Gold 1-20 claims, owned by E.O. Chisholm, were optioned in 1973 by New Cinch Uranium Ltd. Work during 1973-74 included geological mapping, trenching and 1,004 of diamond drilling in 4 holes; the option was abandoned in April 1974.

Brican Resources Ltd. in 1981 optioned a 100% interest in the Top claims. Geological, geophysical and geochemical surveys and backhoe trenching were reported. Diamond drilling was done in 1983.
