## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

.... almost flat-lying, schistose, siliceous sediments into which considerable quartz has been injected in a very irregular manner. The quartz carries some pyrite, galena, sphalerite, molybdenite, and a little siderite." (Walker, 1930).

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc, molybdenum.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showings are located at approximately the 2,700 foot elevation on the east side of Foghorn Creek, 1¼ miles south of Birch Island.

The showings were apparently held as the Birch Island claim by T. Montgomery in 1927. The property was held in 1930 by a Mr. Millar, of Birch Island. The workings at that time included a 57 foot long adit and open cuts.

Ground in this vicinity was in later years staked as the Spar 36 (Lot 5486) and Lil 13 (Lot 5490) claims. These claims were part of a large claim group acquired in 1951 by Rexspar Uranium & Metals Mining Co. Limited. Surface diamond drilling was done on Spar 36 claim in 1973 by Kerr Addison Mines Limited under a joint venture agreement with Denison Mines Limited.
