DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Uraninite, pyrite, fluorite, and biotite replace trachytic volcanic rocks similar in occurrence to the Rexspar occurrence but of lower grade.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 2,000 feet elevation on Lute Creek, 2½ miles southeast of Birch Island.

During 1952 Deer Horn Mines Limited staked the Stan and Clark groups of 8 claims each, adjoining the Rexspar Uranium & Metals Mining Co. Limited property on the north-east. An additional 17 claims in the Yule, Lynn, Cam, and Art groups were staked and held in trust for the company. The Round 1-4 claims were added by staking in 1953. Several radioactive zones were located during the fall of 1952 by prospecting. Diamond drilling was begun in December 1953 to explore the main radioactive area and 2 holes were completed before the program terminated in mid January 1954.

Rexspar leased the property in 1954 and carried out 1,406 feet of diamond drilling in 5 holes on mineralization designated the 'G' zone. Seventeen claims were subsequently allowed to lapse and 11 were retained under lease by Rexspar. Further diamond drilling by Rexspar in 1957 totalled 1,169 feet in 2 holes. The lease was subsequently allowed to lapse.

The Bullion 1-12 and Pat 2-4 claims, owned in 1968 by J.J. Doyle covered ground formerly held by Deer Horn Mines Limited. The Granby Mining Company Limited optioned the property in 1968 and carried out trenching and bulldozer stripping. In 1969 Granby carried out 787 feet of diamond drilling in 1 hole.
