DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Two showings occur on this property: the northwesterly one consists of 5 or 6 white quartz veins, from 20 to 30 feet apart, mineralized with galena, sphalerite, and minor chalcoppyrite. The veins strike northeasterly and dip very steeply northwest, cutting a northeasterly dipping sequence of grey limestone, dolomite, and grey and green phyllite. The other showing, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the southeast, consists of galena and sphalerite mineralization in discontinuous lenticular replacement zones in a similar sequence of rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

These showings lie at about the 5,600 foot elevation on the steep hillside east of the east fork of La Forme Creek, some 16 miles northeast of Revelstoke. The Mastodon mine lies about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the northwest.

No record has been found of early exploration work on this property although three Crown-granted claims (Lots 4506, 4507, and 5068) are located in the vicinity; the ground may have originally been included in the McCallum group of claims which were prospected in 1900.

Three recorded claims, the Little Slide Nos. 1, 2, and 3, were held by E.M. Shea of Salmon Arm in 1959. During the year several open cuts were made on the showings.
