HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This showing lies along the south side of Tokumm Creek, near its junction with the Vermilion River, about 36 miles east-southeast of Golden.

The showing was staked in 1912 as a single row of 14 claims; these were turned over to Zenith Mines, Limited, which was incorporated in December of that year. A subsidiary company, The Tokumm Creek Mines, Limited, was incorporated in November 1917 to acquire 7 of the claims. Only limited exploration work, mainly for assessment requirements, has been reported; this included trenching, and driving a short adit. About 10 tons of ore were reported shipped to Trail in 1915. The company charters were surrendered in 1924 and 1923, respectively.
