The Blue Bell claim is situated about a mile southeast of Illecillewaet. The last recorded work on the claim was in 1899. At that time workings consisted of a shaft 45 feet in depth and a tunnel 140 feet in length.

Samples of galena are reported to have assayed 120 oz/ton silver and 72% lead.
