The quarry is located one- quarter mile east of the head of Winter Cove. British Columbia Lightweight Aggregates Ltd., in 1959 stripped an area about 500 feet wide and 1,500 feet long fo a quarrying operation. In September 1959 the company began producing coated light-weight aggregate by expanding shale in a plant located on the peninsula between Winter Cove and Lyall Harbour. The shale is crushed to 5/8 inch size and passed through an oil-fired rotary kiln. The high temper- ature causes the shale fragments to expand to form porous cinder-like individuals that acquire a thin glassy skin or outer coating and a rounded shape. When in full operation the plant produced 325 cubic yards of expanded shale aggre- gate per day. Operations ceased in November 1974.			
DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT The exposed bedrock is shale of the Upp Group. It is blue-grey when fresh but weat ish.
