REMARKS

Copper Island is the largest of a chain of islands separating the middle and eastern channels of Barkley Sound. It is about 5 miles long and 2 miles wide. Highest elevation 1800 ft.

Principal magnetite exposures are on the Mountain claim.

The deposit is not large and there is little to indicate that it would assume economic importance.
