DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite and bornite occur in fissures in shear zones in metamorphosed limestone.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The claims lie at about the 2,000 foot elevation northwest of Stewardson Inlet, an arm of Sydney Inlet, on the west coast of Vancouver Island. The claims lie northwest of and adjoin the Indian Chief group (see 92 E/8, Cu 1).

The Prince 1-8 claims (Lots 572-579, respectively) were staked in about 1898 and in 1899 were sold to Dr. T.R. Marshall & associates, of Glasgow, Scotland. During 1901 and 1902 two adits and a connecting winze, totalling about 200 feet, were driven. No further work was reported although the claims were kept in good standing into the 1920's. Copper Hill Mines, Limited, incorporated November 1928, is reported to have owned the property and carried out a little development work in 1929.

The Prince and Indian Chief groups were owned in 1956 by X.Y.Z. Metals, Limited, and H.E. Dendoff. Newkirk Mining Corporation Limited optioned the combined property in 1956 but no work was reported on the Prince group. London Pride Silver Mines Ltd. held an option on the combined property in 1963 and diamond drilling was reported in 3 surface holes on the Prince group.

Texada Mines Ltd. optioned the property from the Estate of Hubert E. Dendoff in 1973. Underground geological mapping was reported on Prince 4 claim.
