DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Several trenches here expose granitic rock of the Coast Range batholith, in which pink-weathering feldspar and epidote are conspicuous. Locally the rock is mineralized with pyrite, chalcopyrite, specularite and magnetite. Selected samples of chalcopyrite assayed: gold, 0.02 oz/ton; silver, 11 oz/ton, and copper 17.2%.
