The showing consists of a mineralized vein traceable for 100 feet, varying in width from 2 inches to 1 foot (average width about 4 inches) in granodiorite. The vein is coarsely crystalline and is composed chiefly of quartz irregularly intergrown with feldspar and some mica in irregular patches and veinlets. Chalcopyrite, bornite and molybdenite make up perhaps 10% of the vein matter.

> The Thistle claim is located about one mile northeast of the summit of Mt. Hayes. Development consists of 2 short adits, one 25 feet above the other, connected by a short inclined level and a stope. This work, done by the Vancouver Exploration and Development Company in 1904-05, showed the vein to be too small and too low grade to be of economic importance.

The showing was restaked in 1939-40 as the Duff and Good Strike mineral claim, registered in the name of H.C. Duffus. In 1942 these were leased to the Ladysmith Copper Syndicate but apparently no further development work was carried out.
