Deposits are located about 600 ft. above level of river. Two outcroppings visible almost 2000 ft. apart.

Sample from prospect tunnel analysed:

CaO	:	32.70%
So <sub>3</sub>	:	46.72%
H <sub>2</sub> O	:	20.60%
