The property is located on Guichon Creek some 21 km north-northwest of Merritt.

Showings discovered in 1898 were staked as King Solomon's Mines (Lot 1010) and Midnight (Lot 1011). Work in 1898-99 included a 40' adit. The claims were Crown-granted in 1901 to W.E. Deeks.

The Manchester claim (Lot 1216) was located about $\frac{1}{2}$ km downstream. Work was reported in a 30' shaft. The claim was owned from about 1900 by J. Clapperton, who obtained a Crown-grant in 1906. The adjacent London claim (Lot 1217) was Crown-granted to C.J. Whinney in 1906.

The King Solomon Dream claim (Lot 1254), located just north of the Manchester claim, was held in 1901 by the Broomhead Syndicate as part of the nearby Aberdeen property (82 I/7, CU 6). Assessment work was reported in 1903. The claim was Crown-granted in 1906 to R.M. Woodward.

Bethlehem Copper Corporation held the King Solomon Dream and London Crown-grants and about 210 located claims (H.C. group) in the 1950's. Northwestern Explorations, Limited optioned the property and carried out geophysical and geochemical surveys, bulldozer trenching and 1,565' of diamond drilling in 6 holes; the option was given up in November 1957. Work by Bethlehem in 1968 and 1970 included geological mapping, trenching and 470' of percussion drilling in 3 holes.
