DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Zoned fluorite and quartz veins varying in width from 2 to 12 cm occur along a south dipping fault zone in Triassic andesite of the Nicola Group.

Drilling on the Microgold group cut quartz-carbonate-fluorite veins; fluorite veinlets from a few mm to 2 cm in width are common.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the southwest edge of Kullagh Lake, 2 km north of Stump Lake and some 44 km northeast of Merritt.

The Redbird property was owned by W. Huxley, of Kamloops, in the period 1976-1980. Work included trenching by drilling and blasting.

On the Microgold claims, located in this vicinity and held by Chevron Canada Resources Ltd in 1983, diamond drilling was done in one hole to a depth of 409.7 m.

The property was held in 1986 as the Cin, Dy and Microgold groups by BP Resources Canada Limited. Work included a magnetometer survey over 62 km, a VLF electromagnetic survey over 4 km, and a geochemical soil survey (688 samples).
