HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This group consists of 17 Conbra claims on the southeast side of Chism Creek, a tributary of Cadwallader Creek, about 10 miles southeast of Gold Bridge, and four Conbra Gold claims farther to the southeast between Aggie and Copp Creeks. The showings are between 5,900 and 6,300 feet elevation.

William Haylmore staked the Conbra Gold claims in 1946 and the Conbra claims between 1944 and 1948; surface stripping and open-cut work was reported.

OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

These showings consist of quartz veins, some in carbonate zones, and some in unaltered rocks in an easterly-trending augite diorite projection of the Bendor Batholith. The augite diorite is 750 feet wide, bordered on the north by massive greenstone and on the south by serpentine. Some of the outcrops have rust or malachite stainings. The quartz lenses trend northerly and vary greatly in size. The highest assays from samples taken in 1947 across nearly all quartz veins and rusty zones was 0.01 oz./ton gold.
