DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 13-1973 indicates the property is underlain by Mid Triassic and (?) older sedimentary rocks at the southwest contact of the Bendor Pluton. Mineralization is of the contact-metamorphic type and has transformed a narrow limestone bed to epidote-lime garnet rock heavily mineralized in places with pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite. Low assays in gold have been reported.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at 4,500 foot elevation on the northeast side of Cadwallader Creek some 12 km southeast of Bralorne.

The showings were staked as the Moose 1-8 claims by Hans Pederson prior to 1933; the claims were transferred to a private company Bramoose Gold Mines, Ltd which was incorporated in May 1933. Exploration work included trenching and driving two adits totalling 76 ft.

The claims subsequently lapsed and the ground was restaked in 1944 by Delina C. Noel as the Peridot 1-2 claims. Work included extending the two adits to 86' and 36' respectively.
