DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The workings explored mineralized quartz leads lying along or close to a contact between greenstones and sedimentary rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Golden Ledge property straddles the Hurley River, one-half mile below its junction with Cadwallader Creek. The property consisted of four Crown-granted and twenty-one located mineral claims. Between 1937 and 1953 the group was developed by the Golden Ledge Syndicate, Limited, who drove five levels and over 2,200 feet of drifts and crosscuts on the lower three levels.
