DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

These claims are underlain by quartz diorite of the post lower Cretaceous Bendor Batholith. The mineralization consists of stibnite, realgar and orpiment in a quartz or quartz-carbonate gangue. Assays run 0.01 oz./ton Au; 12.7 and 13.3 oz./ton Ag; 14.72% and 16.63% Sb.

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver, gold.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property consists of 18 claims, the Rock 1 to 10 (29834-29843) and the Roy 1 to 8 (33913-33920). They are located at an elevation of 8,000 feet on the western slopes of Mount Truax, about 4.5 miles southeast of Gold Bridge.

Early prospecting work was done in the area in the 1930's. It is possible that the Birthday, B & M, Stewart and Commerce properties (see 92 J/15, Sb 7) were located on the same ground as this property.

In 1964, Martin Retan, Ed Chase and Babe Belanger, staked claims, formerly held by Andy Simons, covering basically the same area as the Rock claims. Frobex Limited acquired a 25% interest in the property and explored it in partnership with others. Under the supervision of Mr. Chase, a minor trenching programme was carried out. Results proved disappointing and in 1965 the claims were forfeited to the Crown.

In 1970, Westview Mining Co. Ltd. purchased the Rock claims from R.G. Steeves and staked the Roy claims. About 8.5 line-miles of magnetic and electromagnetic surveying was done; the Roy claims subsequently lapsed.
