DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Mass of limestone within the Coast Range batholith has been converted to a fine to medium grained marble. Throughout the marble are a few bands and lenses of skarn and other impurities, particularly in the adits, where lamprophyre dykes occur, as well as small streaks and fracture fillings and disseminations of pyrite, chalcopyrite, bornite, sphalerite, galena and pyrrhotite occur. The marble is white, grey, greenish grey, cream, brown, and light azure blue.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Located on Knight Inlet, 150 miles northwest of Vancouver. On the east side of Matsui Creek, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of the beach.

Prior to 1920, Princess Copper Mining Company drove adits on sulphide min. Cambria Copper Co. in 1928. Work in 4 adits totalling about 560 feet.

P.B.M. Exploration in 1966 - investigated the marble.

1969 - Knight Inlet Resources Ltd. formed to develop the marble potential of the property. D.D. in 3 holes.

Associated minerals or products of value - Copper, lead, zinc.
