DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

This showing occurs in a metamorphosed zone of andesitic volcanic rock, near its contact with granitic intrusives. Mineralization consists of pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite in a gangue of quartz, garnetite, epidote, hornblende and andesitic country rocks. The showing strikes approximately west. Open cuts have exposed the body for a distance of 300 feet. It covers the volcanic rock in a blanket-like fashion but dips quite steeply at the bottom of the incline shaft. A grab sample taken from the dump in 1916 assayed 0.1 oz./ton gold; 2.6 oz./ton silver and 6.2% copper.

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver, copper.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is situated about two and a half miles southeast of Granite Bay on Quadra Island. In 1916 it consisted of two claims, the Trilby and Eastern claims owned by Mrs. Polly Fox. Development work consisted of a series of open cuts along the strike of the deposit and a shaft sunk to a depth of twenty feet. In 1919, the Trilby claim, Lot 998, covering 51.65 acres was Crown-granted to Mrs. Fox.

In 1969, Western Mines Limited acquired by option and staking a total of 202 claims in this area (see Copper Road, 92 K/3, Cu 4). It is quite possible that the ground covered by these old claims was included in the group.
