DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Property underlain by medium grained quartz monzonite of the Upper Jurassic Coast Range Batholith. Dykes are common and range from fine grained aplites to medium grained diorites. A wide shear zone 800-1,200 ft. strikes about E-W across the island. Pyrite and a few specks of chalcopyrite occur locally along the zone.
