DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT
 The southeast shore of the Island overlies altered volcanic greenstones of the Upper Triassic Karmutsen Formation.
 Epidote, quartz, pyrite, chalcopryrite, bornite, calcite, chlorite and zeolites occur in fractures and amygdules in the volcanic rock.
 A 1916 sample assayed 3% copper with minor gold and silver. (M.M.A.R. 1916, p. 343).

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold, silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
 The property is located between sea level and 100 feet elevation on the southeast shore of Hanson Island about 10 miles east of Alert Bay.
 The Princess group of three mineral claims was located about 1900 by Raper, Law and Hamilton. By 1916 a shaft was sunk at the beach, a 500 north-south adit was driven along a fracture plane, and at 125 feet elevation a 160 foot shaft was sunk which connected to the adit.
 In 1971 Croydon Mines Ltd. held the Haw 1 to 3 claims and carried out a geochemical soil survey. In May 1973 the Company became Aalenian Resources Ltd.
